







Now press CNTRL+C to copy the selected black lines. Make a new layer and name it Links, press CNTRL+V to paste the lines. Delete the main background layer, dont need it anymore, make a new layer and paint it all in with white. Make sure your Links Layer is above the white background layer you just made.



Now right click your Links layer and go to Blending Options. Check off what I got checked off:
